# ALLEGAN CONSERVATION DISTRICT

### **Conifers:**

Balsam Fir - Quebec (Abies balsamea)

Mature height: 60 to 70 feet Mature width: 20 to 25 feet

**Light exposure:** full or partial sunlight **Soil preference:** moist, but well-drained

Growth rate: slow (less than 12 inches per year)
Wildlife attraction: small mammals & birds
Seedling size & age: 6-12" & Plug +1





## Canaan Fir (Abies intermedia)

Mature height: 40 to 50 feet Mature width: 20 to 25 feet

**Light exposure:** full sun & partial shade **Soil preference:** well-drained, acidic soil

Growth rate: 1 to 2 feet per year Wildlife attraction: red squirrels & birds Seedling size & age: 8-14" & Plug +1

#### Norway Spruce (Picea abies)

Mature height: 40 to 60 feet tall Mature width: 25' to 30' wide Light exposure: full sun Soil preference: moist but well-drained, slightly acidic soil Growth rate: 2 to 3 feet per year Wildlife attraction: owls & hawks Seedling size & age: 8-14" & 2-1





White Pine (Pinus strobus)
Mature height: 80 to 100 feet

Mature width: 20 to 40 feet Light exposure: full sun

Soil preference: well-drained, sandy soils with a moderate acidity Growth rate: 2 to 3 feet per year Wildlife attraction: songbirds &

small mammals

**Seedling size & age:** 6-12" & 2-1



### White Spruce (Picea glauca)

Mature height: 40 to 60 feet Mature width: 25 to 30 feet

**Light exposure:** prefers full sun but tolerates some shade

Soil preference: well-drained, moist fertile and can tolerate a considerable range in soil pH

**Growth rate:** 12 to 15 inches per year

Wildlife attraction: valuable nesting plant for many bird species

Seedling size & age: 8-14" & 2-1

Allegheny Serviceberry (Amelanchier laevis)



Mature height: 30 to 40 feet Mature width: 15 to 20 feet Light exposure: full sun to

partial shade

Soil preference: moist, well-

drained

**Growth rate:** fairly quickly **Wildlife attraction:** insects, birds, & small mammals

Seedling size & age: 12-18" &

#### Ninebark (Physocarpus)

Mature height: 5 to 10 feet Mature width: 6 to 8 feet

Light exposure: full sun to light

shade

**Soil preference:** moderately moist, well-draining soil with a pH that is

neutral to slightly acidic

**Growth rate:** 2 feet or more per year **Wildlife attraction:** honey bees,

native bees, & butterflies

**Seedling size & age:** 6-12" & 2-0





### Paw Paw (Asimina)

Mature height: up to 25 feet Mature width: 15 to 20 feet

Light exposure: performs best on sites with

full-sun exposure

\*seedlings, will not survive under full sun conditions- young shoot sensitive to sunlight Soil preference: slightly acid, deep, fertile,

and well-drained

Growth rate: 1 to 2 feet per year

Wildlife attraction: Opossums, foxes,

squirrels, raccoons, & birds
\*needs some protection from wind
Seedling size & age: 6-12" & 2-0

#### Red Maple (Acer rubrum)

Mature height: 60 to 90 feet Mature width: 30 feet

**Light exposure:** full sun to part shade **Soil preference:** well-drained, sandy, loamy

acidic soil

Growth rate: 12 to 18 inches a year Wildlife attraction: squirrels & chipmunks Seedling size & age: 6-12" & 2-0



### <u>Tulip Poplar</u>

## (Liriodendron tulipifera)

Mature height: 70 feet Mature width: 40 feet

Light exposure: full sun or partial

sur

**Soil preference:** moderately moist, deep, well drained, loose textured

soils

**Growth rate:** 3 to 5 feet per year **Wildlife attraction:** honey bees,

native bees, & hummingbirds
Seedling size & age: 12-18" & 1-0



Mature height: 3 to 6 feet Mature width: 6 to 12 feet wide

**Light exposure:** full sun to part shade

**Soil preference:** slightly acidic, moist but well-drained soils **Growth rate:** 3 to 6 feet (takes two years for each cane to produce fruit)

Wildlife attraction: small mammals, birds, & pollinators

**Seedling size & age:** 12-18" & 1-0
