| Plentiful Pollinator $\$ 128.00$ | This is the garden kit that supplies some of the best natives to attract a wide range of different pollinators. Ohio Horsemint and Sand Coreopsis make great groundcovers under 2' tall. Hairy Mountainmint, Purple Hyssop, and Boneset are long bloomers in late summer followed by Joe-Pye weed. Pair Showy Goldenrod with Sky Blue Aster for an autumn blooming explosion. Full sun, dry to medium for all except Boneset, and Joe Pye weed who prefer a more moist location. |  |  |
| Xeriscape $\$ 128.00$ | The perfect kit for a "lazy" gardener. Xeriscape means irrigation free, once established. These plants are tough as nails. Hairy Beardtongue and Whorled Milkweed are edging plants for hummingbirds and butterflies. Western Sunflower is a silvery, aggressive groundcover that spreads like a mat. Butterfly Weed, Yellow False Indigo, and Purple Coneflower are long blooming under 3.5' tall. Savanna Blazing Star and Smooth Blue Aster bloom in late summer to early autumn. |  |  |
| Shade Enhancer \$128.00 | Shade is a difficult location to beautify, but don't worry, we have you covered! Ginger has soft, heart-shaped leaves that make a graceful groundcover. Zig-Zag Goldenrod has interesting whorled flowers and spreads as a 2' mat. Hummingbirds will visit Columbine, Yellow Hyssop, Cardinal Flower, and Great Blue Lobelia. False Sunflower is long blooming and pairs well with Blue Wood Aster. Cardinal Flower and Great Blue Lobelia prefer consistently moist soil while the others prefer dry to medium. |  |  |
| $\begin{aligned} & \text { SC/T/E } \\ & \$ 150.00 \end{aligned}$ | Plants of Special Concern, Threatened, and Endangered are what you will find here. It is important to keep using these so they do not become Extirpated (locally extinct in MI). Use Silky Aster-SC, Prairie Coreopsis-E, and Hairy Petunia-T as low groundcovers. Downy Sunflower-T and Prairie Sage have silver foliage and aggressively spread. Rattlesnake Master has unique globe shaped flowers. The Clustered Mountainmint blooms June-August. Bayberry shrubs provide food/cover for birds. |  |  |
